Conscience Rights Bill Update:

In the previous parliament, Kelly Block- MP from Saskatchewan sponsored a Conscience Rights Bill to protect medical professionals from being forced to participate in medical assistance in dying. The bill didn't go to a vote before the election was called.

Kelly is now introducing a nearly identical Conscience Rights Bill in this parliament.
