CNEWA Project: Pieta Bhavan, support for a drinking water well

Location: Pothy, Kerala, India in the Archdiocese (Archeparchy) of Ernakulam

As this is the second year of our National CWL focus "Care for our Common Home"; all councils are asked to take part in the Pieta Bhavan Project and donate to this worthy cause.

Pieta Bhaven is a Christian home for more than sixty women with intellectual disabilities. The home provides food, clothing, shelter and medical treatment, and additional care for some residents unable to care for themselves. Some women receive skills training and make items such as rosaries and soap.

It is vital to have suitable wells in Kerala to keep the water clean and drinkable for daily use.

Currently, Pieta Bhavan has an open well in need of repair. The rusted cover fell into the well and needs replacing. As residents of Pieta Bhavan depend on this well for drinking water, it needs to be fixed to prevent any contamination from flooding.
