- Like to browse the web and would be happy to monitor the Diocesan, Provincial and National websites for information;
- Are creative and could make posters to advertise CWL projects, membership drives and other promotions; and
- May enjoy editing and/or suggesting new strategies to deliver the message. Having an
  idea person can often be beneficial to a Council stuck on doing the same thing all the
  time.
